GENERAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Conditions that cause muscle and joint pain can indicate a serious condition requiring professional evaluation, diagnosis and treatment. Seek professional care for such conditions.

 Neurosensory Application – Stretch the Muscle NOT the Tape – Is used to reduce discomfort and restore muscle strength when there is a painful condition.

- Apply the base (section 1) with no stretch in the muscle or tape.
- · Stretch the Muscle and/or Joint.
- Apply each additional section of the Power Strip selected with no stretch in the tape. After each section is applied, rub over top of the tape to activate the adhesive.
- Once the Power Strip is fully applied, rub the tape once again to further activate the adhesive.
- 2. Structural Application Stretch the Tape NOT the Muscle - Is used when you want to support a muscle or joint by preventing potentially harmful ranges of motion from occurring.
- Apply the base (section 1) with no stretch in the muscle or tape.
- Once the base is applied, shorten the muscle and or joint the tape is being applied to and then stretch the middle portion of the additional sections of the Power Strips selected and apply the tape to the shortened muscle. Make sure that the end of each section applied does not have any stretch in the tape.
- The desired amount of restriction of motion will determine how much the tape is stretched.

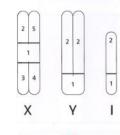

HOW TO USE POWER STRIPS

SKIN PREPARATION

- Apply to clean, dry, hairless skin, clipping the hair may be necessary, and wait 45-60 minutes before exercise or bathing.
- Never apply to irritated or broken skin. A
 test strip may be applied to determine if
 any skin sensitivity results.
 If itching or irritation occurs, remove the
 tape immediately and contact your
 health care provider. No increased
 discomfort should be experienced while
 wearing the tape.

APPLICATION PRINCIPLES

- Before applying the support, tear off all perforations along that black lines on the back of the strips.
- When applying the tape, remember to "Remove the backing from the tape, not the tape from the backing".
- Apply the base (Section 1) with no stretch in the tape or muscle.
- Do not touch the adhesive side of the tape while applying. Doing so will decrease the adhesive strength on the skin and may lead to early peeling.

- As you remove the backing from the tape, peel back the paper backing in small amounts at a time as you apply the tape to the skin. Continue this process until 90% of the tape is adhered to the skin, at which point you can remove the backing completely off.
- Never stretch the end portion of each section of the tape, only the central portions can be stretched and ensure that the ends of the tape are touching skin only.
- After each section of tape you apply, gently rub over the top of the tape to smooth out any creases and to activate the glue. It is very important to remember to rub the tape from the start to the end of each section.
- When it comes time to remove the Power Strip, stretch the skin under the tape, gently pull the tape off in the direction of hair growth. Do not remove the tape while wet.
